5. I am also enclosing a COVID Pledge which may be taken tomorrow or any subsequent suitable days by teachers and frontline workers.

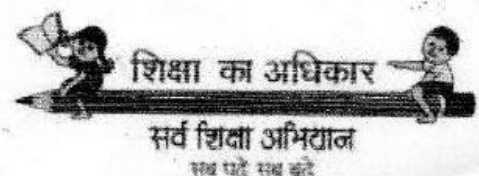

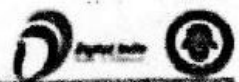
In view of above, it is requested that above instructions may be complied with as per revised schedule by each school so that safety of the students and staff etc. to be ensured once the schools are reopened.
